RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 FEE SCHEDULE RELATED TO STREET AND SIDEWALK VENDORS

In 2018 and 2022, the State Legislature passed Senate Bill 946 (2018) and Senate Bill 972 (2022) to regulate allowable enforcement measures for both General Law and Charter Cities for addressing street and sidewalk vendors; and

On December 16, 2025, City Council adopted Ordinance 2025-12-16-1212, amending Title 5, Title 8, and Title 12 and repealing chapter 12.76 of the SMC to update regulations for street and sidewalk vendor regulations; and

The City seeks to implement fines consistent with State Law to address street and sidewalk vending conducted in violation of the proposed amendments to the SMC. In addition, the City seeks to amend fee schedules for the recovery of costs for work created by the activities of vendors and their clients in public parks as allowed by the provisions of State Law; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the amendment of the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Fee Schedule to update new fees concerning street and sidewalk vendors attached as Exhibits 1, 2, and 3 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Manager is authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
