RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FILING OF NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE01-25, APPROVING THE PROJECT PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$646,927 TO TNT INDUSTRIAL CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR THE REGIONAL WASTEWATER CONTROL FACILITY SOUTH BIOSCRUBBER REPAIRS

On January 23, 2025, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed bids offered for the Regional Wastewater Control Facility South Bioscrubber Repairs Project; and

TNT Industrial Contractors, Inc. submitted the lowest bid that was regular and responsive in all aspects in the amount of \$646,927; and

The repair of the south bioscrubber at the City's Regional Wastewater Control Facility (RWCF) Headworks Building as described in the proposed Construction Contract for the RWCF South Bioscrubber Repairs (Exhibit 3), the "project", conforms with the City of Stockton General Plan, also satisfies the General Plan based on Policy Land Use – 6.3, and is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Section 15302, Class 2 (c), of the CEQA Guidelines; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Notice of Exemption No. NOE01-25 under CEQA for the RWCF South Bioscrubber Repairs is hereby approved and staff is authorized to file and post it in compliance with CEQA Guidelines section 15062, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The project Plans and Specifications for the RWCF South Bioscrubber Repairs are hereby approved, a copy which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with TNT Industrial Contractors, Inc. of Sacramento, California, in the amount of \$646,927 for the RWCF South Bioscrubber Repairs, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 3 and incorporated by this reference.

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4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are appropriate and necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
