RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A TOBACCO GRANT PROGRAM AWARD FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$976,853

In June 2025, the Stockton Police Department submitted a grant application for the project title: Tobacco Grant Program to fund the expansion of the high performing Tobacco Enforcement Operations; and

The Program is administered by the California Department of Justice Office of the Attorney General; and

The grant provides funding to assist law enforcement efforts that reduce illegal retail sales and marketing of tobacco products to minors and youth. The Special Investigations Team will conduct decoy operations, shoulder tap operations, and undercover buys using specialized equipment to combat sales and advertising of tobacco and e-cigarette products to minors; and

In November 2025, the California Office of the Attorney General notified SPD that the City of Stockton was selected to receive a Tobacco Grant Program award in the amount of \$976,853 with no local match required; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to accept the California Department of Justice Tobacco Grant Program award in the amount of \$976,853 for the period of November 1, 2025, through June 30, 2029, and make all necessary appropriations in compliance with and for the purposes stated in the grant application.

2. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to execute the Tobacco Grant Program award and all related documents to carry out the purpose and intent of the grant award, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

3. The Fiscal Year 2025-26 Annual Budget is amended to appropriate \$976,853 in revenues and expenditures in the Police Department Special Grants account to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.

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4. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
