BUDGET STATUS UPDATE REPORT AND AUTHORIZE BUDGET AMENDMENTS**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) Accepts this budget status report on the unaudited results of the fourth quarter of FY 2024-25.
- 2) Allocates the General Fund Vacancy Savings budget reduction for FY 2024-25 from Other Administration (Non-departmental) category to the following departments:

3) Authorize a FY 2024-25 budget amendment increasing expenditure and revenue appropriations in the Downtown Marina Fund by \$900.

- 4) Authorize a FY 2024-25 budget amendment increasing expenditure and revenue appropriations in the General Liability Insurance Internal Service Fund by \$29,600.
- 5) It is further recommended that the City Manager be authorized to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of the resolution.
