RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE60-23, REALLOCATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDING, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE SWENSON PARK GOLF COURSE FENCE REPLACEMENT, PROJECT NO. WB24033

On October 5, 2023, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Swenson Park Golf Course Fence Replacement, Project No. WB24033; and

The project will remove the existing chain link fence and gates on the south and west sides of the golf course and replace with a new wrought iron fence and two double swing gates; and

Arrow Fence Company is the lowest responsive bidder in the amount of \$230,720 and its bid is regular in all respects; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15301(c) (Existing Facilities) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE60-23 under the CEQA for the Swenson Park Golf Course Fence Replacement, Project No. WB24033, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Council approves the reallocation of Council Discretionary Funding in the amount of \$25,000 from the Pixie Woods Suspension Bridge Replacement, Project No. WP22039, to the Swenson Park Golf Course Fence Replacement, Project No. WB24033.

3. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Arrow Fence Company in the amount of \$230,720, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

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4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
