PROGRAM SNAPSHOT 2023 - 2025

- 52 organizations have gone through the program since 2023
- 93% of alumni still apply program lessons
- A recent Cohort 1 survey found that 60% of organizations have received over \$100,000 in new grant funding







Added 10 new teachers and a counselor



Added 8 new staff



Added 3 new staff

KEY ALUMNI OUTCOMES

 91% state they lead their organizations more strategically

• **79%** maintain consistent outreach efforts

• 74% report improved organizational recognition

69% have formed new or stronger community partnerships

• 75% report better financial practices

80% now conduct regular strategic planning sessions


