## RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT \$1.7 MILLION FROM THE CALIFORNIANSFORALL YOUTH JOBS CORPS ROUND 2 GRANT PROGRAM

The City of Stockton ("City") is interested in promoting workforce development programs, particularly those that endeavor to empower youth; and

The State of California has made funding available for the CaliforniansForAll Youth Jobs Corps, which seeks to provide funding for local governments across the state to create programs that increase employment for underserved youth across California, develop meaningful public service career pathways, and enhance local government capacity to address challenges in key focus areas; and

The State of California awarded the City of Stockton a \$1,773,664 Round 2 Youth Jobs Corps grant to continue the City's youth workforce program, and support local external workforce partners; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Authorize the ratification of a grant agreement with California Volunteers in the amount of \$1,773,664 (Exhibit 1).
- 2. Authorize the City Manager to appropriate grant funds for the CaliforniansForAll Youth Jobs Corps in the amount of \$1,773,664.
- 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
