RESOLUTION TO ALLOCATE GRANT FUNDING FROM THE HOMELESS HOUSING, ASSISTANCE AND PREVENTION (HHAP) PROGRAM TO ST. MARY'S COMMUNITY SERVICES FOR THE PATHWAYS PROJECT OPERATION

The state's HHAP funds are designed to support regionally coordinated efforts between the County, Continuum of Care (CoC) and the City to expand and develop local capacity to address immediate homelessness challenges throughout the state. HHAP funds are focused on moving homeless individuals and families into permanent housing and ensuring those individuals and families maintain their permanent housing; and

Staff recommends that Council approve a resolution authorizing the allocation of HHAP funding to St. Mary's Community Services for Pathways Neighborhood operational support; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Approve and allocate HHAP funding in the amount of \$1,244,210.00 to St. Mary's Community Services for Pathways Neighborhood.
- 2. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to enter into and execute any associated documents and to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
