STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FUNDS, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL SIDEWALK GAP CLOSURE - PHASE 1, PROJECT NO. WT19013/FEDERAL PROJECT NO. ATPSB1L-5008(187)

On August 28, 2025, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Safe Routes to School Sidewalk Gap Closure - Phase 1, Project No. WT19013/Federal Project No. ATPSB1L-5008(187); and

The project will install curbs, gutters, sidewalks, curb ramps, and high visibility crosswalks at four school locations across Stockton - Sierra Nevada Middle School, Victory Elementary, Jane Frederick High School, and Montezuma Elementary School; and

FBD Vanguard Construction, Inc. is the lowest bidder in the amount of \$2,109,395.00; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council authorizes the appropriation of federal Surface Transportation Block Grant Program funds in the amount of \$1,677,428 to the Safe Routes to School Sidewalk Gap Closure - Phase 1, Project No. WT19013/Federal Project No. ATPSB1L-5008(187).

2. The City Council authorizes the appropriation of Community Development Block Grant funds in the amount of \$500,000 to the Safe Routes to School Sidewalk Gap Closure - Phase 1, Project No. WT19013/Federal Project No. ATPSB1L-5008(187).

3. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Safe Routes to School Sidewalk Gap Closure - Phase 1, Project No. WT19013/Federal Project No. ATPSB1L-5008(187).

4. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and FBD Vanguard Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$2,109,395.00, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

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5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
