

Ongoing collaboration efforts of the MMID, Mile Merchants, Hammer Head Security with Stockton Police Department Business Watch Program has helped stem the influx of crime and vagrancy within the district boundary. Additional participation by District Attorney's Office, City Code Enforcement, Behavioral Health Services and Stockton Fire Department, whenever necessary.



Enhanced Maintenance

Downtown Stockton Alliance

- Garbage cleanup and removal is scheduled seven days a week, hand watering of trees & plants happens weekly.
- The sidewalks in the entire district are pressure washed every month.
- The maintenance crew also handles graffiti removal, street tree trimming, and annual pre-emergent pest abatement.



- ➤ 552 hours spent hand watering trees and plants
- ▶9,621 bags of garbage removed
- ➤ 502 hours spent pressure washing sidewalks


