**RESOLUTION TO CREATE NEW CLASSIFIED/REPRESENTED CLASS SPECIFICATIONS OF CODE AND HOUSING ENFORCEMENT OFFICIAL, PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATIONS MANAGER, AND PROPERTY AND RECORDS MANAGER FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND APPROVE THE PROPOSED SALARY RANGES**

It is necessary to establish three new classifications of Code and Housing Enforcement Official, Public Safety Telecommunications Manager, and Property and Records Manager to provide oversight of the Police Department's key service areas of operation; now, therefore,
