RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FOR THE MARCH LANE/EAST BAY MUD BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN PATH CONNECTIVITY IMPROVEMENTS, PROJECT NO. WT17022/FEDERAL PROJECT NO. ATPCML-5008(179)

On July 27, 2021, by Resolution No. 2021-07-27-1222, Council awarded a Construction Contract, in the amount of \$2,784,744.42, to McFadden Construction, Inc. of Stockton, CA, for the March Lane/East Bay MUD Bicycle and Pedestrian Path Connectivity Improvements, Project No. WT17022/Federal Project No. ATPCML-5008(179); and

Contract Change Order (CCO) Nos. 1 through 4, in the amount of \$378,011.05, were previously approved under the administrative change order authority allowed under the original contract; and

Balancing CCO No. 5, in the amount of \$62,287.33, was approved by Council on March 7, 2023, by Resolution No. 2023-03-07-1211; and

Transferring of funding is needed to close out the project and make final payment to the contractor; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the transfer of funds in the amount of \$20,000.00 from the Bicycle Master Plan Program, Project No. WT17003 (formerly PW1703) to the March Lane/East Bay MUD Bicycle and Pedestrian Path Connectivity Improvements, Project No. WT17022 (formerly PW1722)/Federal Project No. ATPCML-5008(179).

2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
