RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A COOPERATIVE PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH CINTAS CORPORATION THROUGH OMNIA PARTNERS TO OBTAIN CITYWIDE UNIFORM RENTAL AND LAUNDRY SERVICES

The City of Stockton (City) provides rental uniforms and laundry service to authorized personnel under the terms of its various bargaining agreements. Some departments require other supplies such as floormats provided through the same rental and laundry services; and

To obtain services which meet the needs of the City, staff reviewed the offerings and capabilities under the OMNIA Partners national cooperative agreement R-BB-19002 with Cintas Corporation; and

Staff verified the OMNIA Partners agreement met competitive processes which were acceptable to the City. Staff evaluated the services and products offered by the Cintas Corporation and confirmed that they met the inventory and material requirements of the City's collective bargaining agreements; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves findings pursuant to Stockton Municipal Code section 3.68.070 in support of an exception to the competitive bidding process for Citywide uniform rental and laundry services:

- a. Contract R-BB-19002 with Cintas Corporation was established through a formal competitive solicitation process through OMNIA Partners.
- b. The scope and criteria of contract R-BB-19002 with Cintas Corporation for Facilities Management Products and Solutions meet the City's needs.
- c. Use of existing procurement agreements fosters efficient use of public funds and helps streamline local government procurement practices.

2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute a purchase agreement with Cintas Corporation to provide uniform rental and laundry services through a cooperative contract awarded by OMNIA partners, for a total not to exceed amount of \$1,354,200 for a four-year term, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
