STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE9-24, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE LOCAL STREET RESURFACING PROGRAM FY 2021-22 SB1 – CAPE SEAL, PROJECT NO. WT22003

On February 1, 2024, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Local Street Resurfacing Program FY 2021-22 SB1 – Cape Seal, Project No. WT22003; and

The project will apply a cape seal treatment to approximately six centerline miles of various residential roadways citywide; and

VSS International, Inc. is the lowest responsive bidder in the amount of \$912,000, and its bid is regular in all respects; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE9-24 under the CEQA for the Local Street Resurfacing Program FY 2021-22 SB1 – Cape Seal, Project No. WT22003, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Local Street Resurfacing Program FY 2021-22 SB1 – Cape Seal, Project No. WT22003.

3. The City Council approves the appropriation of the Gas Tax fund balance in the amount of \$250,000 to the Local Street Resurfacing Program FY 2021-22 SB1 – Cape Seal, Project No. WT22003.

4. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and VSS International, Inc. in the amount of \$912,000, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

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5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are appropriate and necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
