RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO PROVIDE PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-25 ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE NORTH NEWCASTLE STORM DRAINAGE BASIN ASSESSMENT DISTRICT'S PROPOSED BUDGET, PRELIMINARILY APPROVE AND CONFIRM THE ENGINEERS' ESTIMATE CONTAINED IN THE PROPOSED BUDGET, AND SET A PUBLIC HEARING ON JUNE 4, 2024

The Council, pursuant to proceedings under its Resolution of Intention No. 2020-12-15-1501, adopted December 15, 2020, ordered the formation of a maintenance district designated as "North Newcastle Storm Pump Station and Basin Assessment District", as described in and in accordance with such Resolution on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars; and referred the maintenance of the improvements to the Engineer of Work of the City for the preparation of a proposed budget to be filed with the City Clerk, showing the anticipated annual cost of the maintenance of the improvements; and

The Engineer of Work has made and filed with the City Clerk a proposed budget in the net sum of \$72,680.84 for the ensuing Fiscal Year (FY), which has been presented to this Council for consideration; and

The Council has duly considered the proposed budget and the assessments proposed for the maintenance of the improvements, and finds that the proposed budget is sufficient, and that neither the budget, nor any part thereof, requires or should be modified in any respect; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The proposed budget for the maintenance of the improvements for the FY 2024-25 is hereby, preliminarily, approved, and confirmed.
- 2. The Engineers' estimate of the itemized and total costs and expenses of the maintenance and of the incidental expenses in connection therewith, contained in the proposed budget be, and each of them are, hereby, preliminarily, approved, and confirmed.
- 3. Tuesday, June 4, 2024, 5:30 p.m., in the regular meeting place of the Council, Council Chamber, City Hall, Stockton, California, is appointed and fixed as the time and place when and where the Council will consider and finally act upon the proposed budget, provided that the Council may change such time to a later time as it shall determine.

4. That the City Clerk shall publish twice in The Record , a newspaper of
general circulation, at least ten (10) days before the hearing date, notice of the preliminary
approval of the proposed budget, which notice shall contain: A statement of the time,
place, and purpose of the hearing on the proposed budget; a statement of the total
estimated cost of the annual maintenance of the improvements; a reference to the report
on file in the Office of the City Clerk, which shows the amount, as shown by the proposed
budget, to be assessed against each parcel in the district; a statement that any person
interested may file a protest in writing as provided in the Stockton Improvement
Procedure Code; and that the Municipal Utilities Department, Telephone (209) 937-8700
is the local department designated by this Council to answer inquiries regarding the
proposed budget and protest proceedings.
