RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANT OF A UTILITY EASEMENT OVER A PORTION OF A PARCEL OWNED BY THE CITY OF STOCKTON TO PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY LOCATED AT 666 WEST WEBER AVENUE

The grant of a utility easement to Pacific Gas and Electric Company, herein more particularly described in the Easement Deed with map and legal description attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference, over a portion of a parcel owned by the City of Stockton is hereby authorized and approved; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The easement interests are being granted to provide a permanent utility easement to Pacific Gas & Electric Company for electrical upgrades and to provide new electric services from PG&E for New City Hall.
- 2. The City's Public Works, Community Development, Municipal Utilities, Police, and Fire Departments and local utilities have been notified of the proposed granting of an easement at the site and there are no objections to the proposed action.
- 3. In accordance with Government Code section 65402, this project/activity has been determined to conform to the City's General Plan Policy Document, as amended.
- 4. This project is categorically exempt under the State CEQA Guidelines as specified in section 15061(B)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines.
- 5. Pursuant to the requirements of Article V, section 510, of the Stockton City Charter, a Notice of Intention to Grant or Sell Real Property Interest has been duly published.
 - 6. Publication of the notice will be paid for by the City of Stockton.
