RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE11-21, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, APPROPRIATING FUNDING, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE INSTALL LEFT-TURN LANES AT AIRPORT WAY AND HAZELTON AVENUE, PROJECT NO. WT19002/FEDERAL PROJECT NO. HSIPL-5008(184)

On October 13, 2022, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Install Left-Turn Lanes at Airport Way and Hazelton Avenue, Project No. WT19002/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(184); and

The project will add left-turn lanes, modify signals with protected left-turn phasing, add sidewalk to close gaps, and improve access for pedestrians on Airport Way. The project will consist of several elements including separate left-turn lanes with protected left-turn traffic signal phasing at Airport Way and Hazelton Avenue, Americans with Disabilities Act curb ramps, sidewalk, curb, gutter, new pavement delineation, and signing; and

The lowest bidder, George Reed, Inc., failed to meet the City's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise goal of 21 percent; and

United Pavement Maintenance, Inc. is the second lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$1,423,590.00 and its bid is regular in all respects; and

Caltrans National Environmental Policy Act determination was received on February 19, 2021. The State determined that the project is a Categorical Exclusion under 23 CFR 771.117(c): activity (c)(3). Similarly, the project is in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code, section 65402; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption NOE11-21 under the CEQA for the Install Left-Turn Lanes at Airport Way and Hazelton Avenue,

Project No. WT19002 (formerly PW1902)/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(184), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

- 2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Install Left-Turn Lanes at Airport Way and Hazelton Avenue, Project No. WT19002 (formerly PW1902)/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(184).
- 3. The City Council approves the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$362,557.40 from the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds to the Install Left-Turn Lanes at Airport Way and Hazelton Avenue, Project No. WT19002 (formerly PW1902)/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(184).
- 4. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and United Pavement Maintenance, Inc. in the amount of \$1,423,590.00, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.
- 5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
