#### Background

AB 562 effective January 1, 2014

Requires local governments report economic development subsidies over \$100,000

Current Reporting Period – 2022

Comprehensive report of all qualifying programs



## Qualifying Programs (≥\$100,000 Subsidy)

- Stockton Economic Stimulus Plan (SESP)
- Public Facility Fee Reduction for Nonresidential Projects
- Greater Downtown Stockton Residential Development Public Facilities Exemption
- Downtown Infill Infrastructure Program
- Office and Industrial Sales Tax Incentive Program

SESP recipients to hire at least 50% Stockton Residents

4,880 Jobs (2,590 Stockton Residents)
