RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH SWIFTCOMPLY FOR STORMWATER MODULE SOFTWARE LICENSE

The Stormwater Division within the Municipal Utilities Department (MUD) is responsible for overseeing and ensuring compliance with the City's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit, which requires comprehensive monitoring and public outreach to manage and mitigate the release of pollutants from the municipal storm drain system; and

To meet various regulatory requirements, the Stormwater Division plans to upgrade its system software to improve inspection documentation and reporting and manage a considerable amount of compliance, enforcement data, and information; and

After evaluation, staff found that SwiftComply stormwater software module met Division requirements for program management and documentation; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract amendment (Exhibit 1 to the Resolution) to the five-year contract with SwiftComply of Pleasanton, California in the not-to-exceed amount of \$154,957, to incorporate a Stormwater module into the Environmental Control enforcement software.
- 2. By this action, the total contract amount will increase to \$384,640 over the five-year term.
- 3. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
