RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FILING OF A NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE 31-23, APPROVING THE PROJECT PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$153,555 TO SAK CONSTRUCTION, LLC, FOR THE BROOKSIDE SOUTH STORM PUMP STATION DISCHARGE PIPES REHABILITATION (PROJECT NO. US24006)

On November 9, 2023, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed bids offered for the Brookside South Storm Pump Station Discharge Pipes Rehabilitation (Project No. US24006); and

SAK Construction LLC is the low bidder in the amount of \$153,555; and

The bid submitted by SAK Construction LLC, is regular and responsive in all aspects; and

The project conforms with the City's General Plan and is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Section(s) 15302, Class 2 (c), of the CEQA Guidelines; The project also conforms with the Stockton General Plan based on Policy Land Use – 6.3; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Approve the filing of the Notice of Exemption No. NOE 31-23 under CEQA for the Brookside South Storm Pump Station Discharge Pipes Rehabilitation (Project No. US24006), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
2. The City Council approves the project Plans and Specifications for the Brookside South Storm Pump Station Discharge Pipes Rehabilitation (Project No. US24006).
3. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with SAK Construction LLC, of O'Fallon, Missouri, in the amount of \$153,555 for the Brookside South Storm Pump Station Discharge Pipes Rehabilitation (Project No. US24006), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.
4. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute all documents, including but not limited to, agreements and amendments.

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5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
